[set up]

We see and hear the word “blessed” often: “#blessed,” “I’m blessed,” “They are blessed,” etc. When someone says “blessed,” what is included and excluded in their understanding and definition of “blessed”?

[digging deeper]

Look up and read Luke 6:17-26.

This passage includes the “beatitudes.” We get the word beatitude from the Latin, “Beatus” meaning “blessed.” What does the word “Blessed” mean? If you need help, here’s a good link to check out: <https://biblehub.com/greek/3107.htm>

Luke records four beatitudes and four woes in these verses. After a quick review, how are the blessings and woes different from what the world would define as blessings as well as what we in our flesh would expect?

Who was Jesus specifically talking to? Are these blessings and woes just for “anybody”? How does this change the meaning of what He said?
