Not coming to church in person yet? We’ve put together a lesson plan so you can have Sunday School at home. The basic concepts are listed on the left, and some activities are printed below. We would also encourage you to use the Parent Cue for extension activities throughout the month. Remember that doing these specific activities isn’t what matters, but leading your child spiritually does matter very much. These are simply tools that we are offering to help you step into or continue on in the role God has given you as a parent.

1. Introduce the Bible Story

Have your child do a movement as fast as he/she can. Bonus points if it’s some sort of work like picking up toys! Then, have your child stop and rest. Repeat with a variety of movements (jump, clap, crawl...) Explain that God worked to create the world. Then He rested.

2. Watch the Bible Story

Pray with your child, asking God to help him/her understand. Watch the “Bible Story with Ollie” video for September 20th.

3. Worship with Song

At cvconline.org/cvckids click the link for the Preschool playlist. Play “God Made It All” and “Who Knows Best.” Sing and dance along.

4. Practice the Memory Verse

Play the classic game of “Red Light, Green Light.” Whenever your child stops for the red light, have him/her say the Memory Verse.

5. Review the Bible Story

Snuggle up somewhere cozy with your child. Read through the story of creation in a children’s Bible. As you relax together, remind your child that God rested after He created the world. Tell your child that God wants us to work hard and then rest.
